

Camp Fitch Summer Family Camping Programs

Family Policies

1. Definition: a FAMILY is defined as a group that lives in one home.
2. **Social Distancing should be maintained at all times with non-family members.**
3. Each family must travel as a group and remain isolated from other groups.
4. **Parents/Guardians are responsible for the supervision of their children at all times.**
5. Cabins/Cabents/Mitchell Lodge rooms are not to be shared with other families.
6. Designated bathrooms with showers are not to be shared with other families.
7. **All family members must carry a mask* at all times.**
8. **All family members must wear a mask* in publicly shared buildings** and when they interact with non-family members between 6 feet and 10 feet distance outdoors.
*Per Pennsylvania guidelines
9. Public restrooms are available during the day. Please wait in line 6 feet apart on marked spots and wait for the door to open and the other guest to leave before you enter. Announce yourself when you enter to ensure the restroom is empty.
10. Families are responsible for any damage to their lodging.
11. All meals will be delivered to your family and can be consumed at your picnic table.
12. Food: do not feed the local wildlife and keep any food in a sealed plastic container.
13. Garbage: please bag your garbage and empty it into trash bins every evening to keep wildlife from visiting.
14. Alcohol is not permitted.
15. Smoking is not allowed in any structure or program area.
16. Driving: Camp Fitch follows Pennsylvania driving laws. There is a 10 mph speed limit around camp and you are encouraged to park by your lodging.
17. Pets are not permitted at Camp Fitch.
18. Camp Fitch will exercise its right to dismiss families for inappropriate and/or dangerous behavior (including failure to adhere to social distancing) with no refund of fees.
19. Check-In: your host will have all of your check-in materials ready and set aside at Schwebel Pavillion at the main entrance. Only 1 family allowed under the pavilion at a time.

Program Policies

1. Programs and activities are not to be shared with other families
2. Programs and activities are through sign-up only with your host.
3. All activity areas are closed without the supervision of Camp Fitch staff.
4. Swimming in Lake Erie requires a Camp Fitch Lifeguard.
5. All children must wear a PFD when swimming or boating in Lake Erie.
6. All guests must wear a PFD when using watercraft at Camp Fitch.
7. All program equipment will be disinfected after each use and aired out for at least 3 hours.

8. Harnesses, helmets, and PFDs will be disinfected after each use and aired out for at least 24 hours.
9. Staff will maintain Social Distancing when they prepare and oversee activities.
10. Individual families can reserve a private room for indoor activities.
11. Rooms used for indoor activities will be disinfected after each use and aired out for at least 3 hours.
12. Outdoor activities are weather and condition dependent.
13. Weapons: no outside weapons are permitted.

Health Policies

1. If any family member show COVID -19 symptoms (fever, cough, or shortness of breath) within 14 days of your scheduled visit, please cancel your visit and receive a full refund.
2. If any family member develops COVID-19 symptoms at camp, please notify your host and return home immediately. The duration of your stay will be refunded.
3. If any family member develops COVID-19 symptoms within 14 days after your time at camp, please notify your host.
4. Parents/guardians are responsible for arranging the care for illness, medical concerns, first aid, and any medications.
5. Hand Sanitizer is available at program areas to use before and after each activity.
