

## **Cancelation Policy**

Cancelation of enrollment is allowed to happen up until two weeks prior before a summer adventure trip begins.

- ❖ Example: trips starting week 4 of camp need to have the camper withdrawn by the beginning of week 2.

If canceled after this period those campers enrolled will still be charged as if they were going on the trip.

There are several variables that go into adventure trip planning. A few of them include the following:

- Dates outfitters are open to the public
- Activity permits that regulate group size
- Vehicle transportation
- Food ordered
- Number of staff assigned

**It is because of these variables why this cancelation policy exists.**

A great example is that if someone cancels three days before the trip runs, Camp Fitch YMCA has already paid for all reservations with rafting companies, campgrounds, and activity permits. As a result of the 2020 pandemic, it is now common for these partnered outfitters to not offer refunds, especially to large groups. Thus, that is why the payment must still be collected because it would be as if the camper were still on the trip.

- × Cancelling two weeks out allows us to get the full amount back from the outfitters we partner with and will also allow someone on the wait list to move up and begin packing for the trip.
